### **Dr. Mohtashim Shamsi**

I completed my B.Sc. (Hon) and M.Sc. degrees from the Department of Chemistry, University of Karachi in 2001 and 2002. In M.Sc., I was awarded a Gold medal for achieving distinction. After working as a chemistry instructor for several years, in 2008 I earned the M.S. degree from Gwangju Institute of Science and Technology (South Korea) in Materials Science and Engineering. Then, I obtained PhD in 2012 under the supervision of Prof. Bernie Kraatz. The thesis entitled "The Electrochemical Studies of DNA Films on Gold Surfaces". Later, I worked for three years as a postdoctoral fellow in Aaron Wheeler's group in the area of Digital Microfluidics, where I developed first DMF chips with integrated electrochemical sensors. Currently, my research interests fall at the interface of Electrochemistry, Biosensors and Microfluidics gearing towards the "Lab-on-a-Chip" technology for point-of-care application.
